TetraTech Update- Mike LaSala

- 3 scenarios completed by TetraTech and data provided to LandStudies
- Results make sense- provides data that supports disconnect between Bay model and provides more realistic view of what can be done
- LandStudies also has version of CAST Tool
- Dennis Auker provided a memo outlining the remaining tasks
 - o PADEP has shown interest in funding- possibly as line item in budget or as grant opportunity
- Kent requested a fact sheet of results- would support need for new technology for implementation and be used to develop financing for new technologies
 - o Mike stated that they could provide this (ACTION ITEM)
- Date for next committee meeting has not been set

NFWF Update- Matt Kofroth

- Project is about 25% complete
- Sept 2014- end of grant- considering requesting a one year no-cost extension
- 3 teams are progressing well
 - o Technical Team Analysis- cost-benefit analysis of BMPs for Little Conestoga- report has been drafted
 - o Municipal team- struggling with finding 2 final pilot municipalities- working to get Manor and W. Hempfield on board
 - o Management team- kick-off event at Wheatland Middle was fairly successful
 - homeowners guide will be ready around July 4 (Chesapeake Stormwater Network is also developing a homeowner's guide applicable Bay-wide)
 - will be available in a number of formats; is partnering with Matt Royer to fund a web developer to make an online version
 - Sept- Train the trainer workshops with Alliance for Chesapeake Bay- and another later in year
 - Also will be developing a cost-sharing way to provide technical assistance for homeowners to implement stormwater BMPs

CFLC Update- Matt Kofroth

- Growing Greener contract with Kleinshmidt is complete- project will perform a basin retrofit
- EFC effort now has 10 municipalities

- Audit is being finalized- costs split 50/50 between CFLC and LCCWC
- \$25 k grant received from PA watersheds- mostly go towards Don's time to work with poultry litter management

LIMC Update- Mike LaSala

• LIMC is shifting gears to focus on non-motorized transportation- looking to implement county wide bicycle/ pedestrian plan

Watershed Group Updates

- Chiques Watershed Expo at Leiderkranz
 - Also considering additional projects on their property- pavement removal, rain gardens, tree plantings
- Pequea- tree planting completed last month; another in fall
 - Fish shocking in August in Strasburg Twp park
- Conewago Creek looking to do a watershed bike tour- July 20
- Growing Greener grant will not be coming out until end of June; deadline likely mid-August
 - Kent asked CFLC to make a decision on application fee for non-LCCWC members to partner with CFLC for grants
- Healthy Watershed Tour of Lititz Run by LandStudies- developing a tour component for the Lanc Co
 engineers group- Mike asked if LCCWC would like to support a grant to support the engineers' tourgroup was supportive- Mike has found one potential grant through DCNR for \$2000
 - o Kent directed Mike to draft a support letter and he will sign it
 - Kent also suggested considering a tour for high school students and/or science teachers (partner with IU)
 - Grant could be applicable to other groups
