- Attention should be on current members and MS4 municipalities
- Homeowner's O&M Guide
 - One page of O&M Guide draft received
 - Working on cutsheets for BMPs and maintenance
 - Hope to coincide with Penn State/Chesapeake Stormwater Network training to be held on October 19th at Landis Homes
